CONTRIBUTOR GUIDELINE

Each article submitted needs to be provided as follows:

- Electronic form using Microsoft Word.
- Email article submissions to mn@mns.org.my.
- Article has to be sent with the author's name, complete mailing address, phone and email contacts.
- General Article For a one page story with pictures the article should be within 400 words.
- Full Feature For a full feature story with pictures the article should be within 400 words to maximum 2500 words depending on the topic.
- Letter to Editor Each letters should be within 400 to 600 words together with pictures.
- If the author believes the article needs to be of a different length, then they should communicate with the editor prior to submission.
- High digital images of at least 1MB or minimum 300 dpi should accompany submitted articles. For full page photos, original images maybe submitted. The resolution should be more than 3MB.
- All images are to be sent in a separate file and not embedded in the article.

Authors should retain a complete copy of their article and visuals. While reasonable care is taken by the Editor, MNS bears no responsibility for materials that may be lost or damaged in transit or during production.

It is also the responsibility of authors to ensure information they submit is accurate. The opinions expressed in this magazine are those of the author and not necessarily those of MNS.

No payment is made for articles, letters or photographs published in this magazine. Contributors may receive one free copy of the issue in which the article appears.
